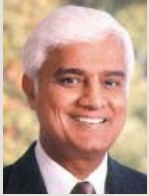

biblical themes in theology, apologetics and spirituality and provides personal mentoring as well. Fellows can also expect to build close friendships with a group of like-minded believers in similar stages of life and career.

Fellows continue in their careers while participating in this yearlong program, and requirements are designed to be achievable for busy professionals with

families. Institute staff and selected guest lecturers provide the teaching, and Institute staff and associates provide mentoring.

Fellows who participate in the program for the full twelve months will grow significantly in their knowledge of biblical truth and can expect to experience substantial spiritual growth, becoming more loving as a spouse and parent, more effective in church, and more credible in the workplace.

Those who complete the program are eligible to participate in a Year Two program, which will continue the teaching and mentoring of Year One. This will also introduce the Fellows to the larger network of C.S. Lewis Fellows in the Atlanta area.
