The Inklings Program is a year-long continuation of the Fellows experience designed for participants to re-engage with both the Fellows community and the curriculum.

Note: Completion of Year One of the Fellows Program is a prerequisite.

The essential commitments	
Commit for the year	The Inklings year runs from August to June
Read the books	One book per month—to be assigned from the additional recommended resources in the Year One curriculum
Attend one day of Fellows retreat	See your local cites fellows page for times and dates
Attend the monthly Inklings discussions	See your local cites fellows page for times and dates
Memorize the verses	Assigned Scripture memory each month

Attend the monthly Fellows lectures	See your local cites fellows page for times and dates
Volunteer	Offer to facilitate one or more of the monthly Inklings discussions
Create groups of two or three	Meet with other Inklings participants (same gender) for prayer, encouragement, and accountability throughout the year
Revisit the highlights	Review your notes and response paper from Year One Fellows for the corresponding monthly theme
Stay overnight at Fellows retreat (Fri and/or Sat)	Make your own arrangements based on lodging availability
